## GREAT NEWS ON THE WATER FILTER PROJECT

**Rotarian Lee Warren** made an announcement at the meeting last week that she and her spouse, **Charles**, are issuing a challenge to the members that as of tonight, they will match funds donated by our club that are earmarked for the **Haiti Water Filter Project**. This is a very generous offer with limits to be set at a later time and hopefully, our club will have more donations to come in as a result. To date, the club has paid **\$600** for water filters and has collected an additional **\$500+** in donated funds to be used to purchase additional water filters. She said that only one of the Water Filters that the club purchased was ruined during the recent earthquake. Lee also reported that the **Haiti Water Filter Project Committee** will be submitting a grant request for additional funds but that only a small percentage of grants will be funded. Clubs from multiple districts are joining in the project. The **Committee** will keep the club updated on any progress with this project.
