SOME SOUTH HILL ROTARY HISTORY

<>> During Tom Smith's first term as president, the Queen's Pot was initiated on December 17, 1987. We are in our 24th year with the Queen's Pot. It was "half to the winner & half to the Queen's Pot." "On March 31, 1988, the club voted that a member must be present to win the Queen's Pot. On July 6, 1989, the club voted to divide the raffle into 3 parts - a third to the winner, a third to the Queen's Pot, and a third to the Rotary Foundation.
<>> On June 5, 1975, club dues were raised to \$50.00 per quarter. One vote against the motion was made by C. H. Morgan.
<>> On January 1, 1989, club dues were raised from \$60.00 per quarter to \$70.00 per quarter.
<>> In July 1941, the club passed a resolution requesting the State Highway Department to maintain a ferry service across the Staunton River, near Clarksville, to connect with the Staunton River State Park.
