WORLD POLIO DAY

World Polio Day, October 24, 2009, is an ideal time to raise public awareness of the ravages of polio and support for its eradication. Communities are more likely to contribute to Rotary's **\$200 Million Challenge** for polio eradication if they know that ending the disease will spare children forever from death and disability caused by polio and save an estimated **\$1 billion** per year that could be spent on overcoming other public health concerns. Rotary clubs and districts are using **World Polio Day**, which falls on Saturday this year, to launch or conclude a full week of activities. **World Polio Day** commemorates **Jonas Salk**, who was born on **October 28th** and developed the original polio vaccine.
